

RECOMMENDATION: I move that the Mayor and Council approve and authorize the Mayor to sign an updated Memorandum of Understanding with Prince George's County that will allow the placement of a portable speed monitoring camera in the northbound lanes of the 7500 block of Adelphi Road.	
BACKGROUND: The City has negotiated with Prince George's County to amend the existing Memorandum of Understanding for Speed Monitoring Systems. The amended agreement is necessary for authorization to place a camera in the Northbound lane of the 7500 block of Adelphi Road. The Mayor's signature is needed on the agreement so it can be returned to Prince George's County for their officials' signatures and implementation.	
NEXT STEPS: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Once MOU is signed by all parties, work with the existing vendor to place a portable camera in the northbound lanes of the 7500 block of Adelphi Road.2. Publish the location of the new camera on the website and local newspaper.
